OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING PUBLIC COMMENT ON THE COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT ("CSBG") 2026/2027 COMMUNITY ACTION PLAN ("CAP") AND APPROVING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE CSBG 2026/2027 CAP TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICES AND DEVELOPMENT ("CSD") AND AUTHORIZING THE CERTIFICATION OF THE COMMUNITY ACTION PLAN AND ASSURANCES

WHEREAS, the Community Services Block Grant ("CSBG") requires a public hearing to accept public comment on the 2026/2027 Community Action Plan ("CAP"); and

WHEREAS, the 2026/2027 CAP has been posted and available for review for a minimum of 30 days, and the public was provided the opportunity to comment on the 2026/2027CAP and any comments provided have been received; and

WHEREAS, the CSBG is available to reduce poverty, revitalize low-income communities, and provide the empowerment for low-income members of the community within Nevada County to achieve economic self-sufficiency; and

WHEREAS, state law requires each eligible CSBG entity to develop a CAP that will assess poverty-related needs, available resources, feasible goals, and strategies to prioritize its services and activities to promote the goals of self-sufficiency among low-income population in its service area; and

WHEREAS, a portion of CSBG grant awards are distributed to community non-profit agencies to fill in the gaps in social services, and/or to provide support to existing priority services to eligible residents of Nevada County; and

WHEREAS, the Adult and Family Services Commission ("AFSC") tripartite board has been designated as the entity to oversee the planning, implementation, and evaluation of CSBG activities; and

WHEREAS, the AFSC tripartite board reviewed the 2026/2027 CAP at their May 13, 2025, meeting and the AFSC tripartite board recommends the approval of the 2026/2027 CAP; and

WHEREAS, the CAP is prepared according to the State instructions and is based on a needs assessment and funding priorities established and approved by the AFSC and the CSBG funding will be spent to improve the conditions of residents living in poverty to increase self-sufficiency; and

WHEREAS, the 2026/2027CAP is required to be submitted to CSD prior to the June 30, 2025, deadline.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors accepts public comment and approves, in substantially the form attached hereto, the submittal of the CSBG 2026/2027 CAP to the State Department of Community Services and Development (CSD) and authorizes the Chair of the Board (or designee, including the Department of Housing and Community Services Director), to sign the Certification of the Community Action Plan (CAP) and Assurances and all other subsequent related documents on behalf of Nevada County.
