OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CONTINUATION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH PLACER COUNTY JUVENILE DETENTION FACILITY TO HOUSE YOUTH FROM NEVADA COUNTY AND AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR-CONTROLLER TO ENCUMBER FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027

WHEREAS, the closure of the Nevada County Youth Center on or before June 30, 2021, was approved by the Board of Supervisors on July 14, 2020, by Resolution 20-318; and

WHEREAS, the Placer County Juvenile Detention Facility has capacity to accommodate additional minors from Nevada County; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Chief Probation Officer has an Agreement in place with Placer County pertaining to housing and the provision of detention and programming services to in-custody youth within the environment of the Placer County Juvenile Detention Facility at the rate of \$125 per bed day, authorized by Resolution 20-437; and

WHEREAS, since the closure of the Youth Center, savings realized from the facility's closure have been utilized to cover the expense related to this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County Probation reviews this Agreement annually to address whether the terms of the Agreement remain in the best interest of Nevada County; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County Probation has reviewed the terms of this Agreement and continues to have the need and desire to detain minors in the Placer County Juvenile Hall Facility, with the next review of this Agreement to complete by June 30, 2027.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Agreement by and between Nevada County and Placer County shall continue and that the Auditor-Controller shall encumber \$150,000 for fiscal year 2026/27, contingent upon the adoption of the fiscal year 2026/27 County Budget.
