## **OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA**

### **RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING A POLICY REGARDING DISRUPTION OF REMOTE ACCESS DURING BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETINGS**

WHEREAS, the Ralph M. Brown Act governs open meetings of local legislative bodies in California; and

WHEREAS, recent amendments to the Brown Act, enacted through Senate Bill 707, require certain legislative bodies to provide the public with access to meetings through two-way telephonic or audiovisual platforms; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors is an “eligible legislative body” subject to these requirements; and

WHEREAS, state law requires eligible legislative bodies to adopt a policy establishing procedures to be followed in the event of a disruption to telephonic or internet service that prevents remote public access to a meeting; and

WHEREAS, the attached policy establishes procedures for pausing open session, making good faith efforts to restore remote access, and resuming the meeting consistent with applicable legal requirements; and

WHEREAS, adoption of this policy is necessary to ensure compliance with state law and to provide clear procedures for the orderly conduct of meetings in the event of a disruption to remote access.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, that the Policy Regarding Disruption of Remote Access During Board of Supervisors Meetings is hereby approved and adopted, effective July 1, 2026, in substantially the same form attached hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Policy shall be maintained by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.
