

## RESOLUTION No.\_\_\_\_

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION TO ADOPT BIDDING DOCUMENTS FOR THE 2022 NEVADA COUNTY ANNUAL STRIPING PROJECT 426640, AND AUTHORIZING; THE PURCHASING AGENT TO SOLICIT BIDS, AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO AWARD AND EXECUTE THE CONTRACT TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER (NOT TO EXCEED \$284,900) OR TO REJECT ALL BIDS; AND THE AUDITOR TO ENCUMBER THE CONTRACT — DISTRICTS I, II, III, IV, AND V

WHEREAS, the County of Nevada desires to re-stripe approximately 88 miles of County-maintained roadways as a routine maintenance and safety measure; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works may make adjustments to the roadways listed as necessary; and

WHEREAS, bidding documents have been prepared to accomplish this work; and

WHEREAS, if all bids exceed the total project budget, the staff will either reject the bids or return to the Nevada County Board of Supervisors for approval to award a larger contract; and

WHEREAS, the work will be funded with Regional Surface Transportation Program and Highway User Tax Account funds and, will be proposed in Road Maintenance FY 22/23 budget code, 1114-30107-703-1000-521120 for FY 22/23; and

WHEREAS, construction is scheduled to begin in summer 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Adopts the bidding documents for the 2022 Annual Striping Project, and authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to sign the Invitation to Bid; and
- 2. Authorizes the Purchasing Agent to solicit bids for the project; and
- 3. Authorizes the Public Works Director to incorporate any final changes into the bid documents before advertising for bids; to award and execute a contract with the lowest responsive bidder, provided the total bid amount does not exceed \$259,000, plus a 10% contingency, for a total project cost not to exceed amount of \$284,900, or to reject all bids if necessary; and to execute construction

- change orders pursuant to Article 9 of the Contract up to the total continency amount; and
  4. Authorize the Auditor to encumber the contract for the bid amount including a 10% contingency.
