SUBJECT: Resolution to award the contract for the 2023 Nevada County Annual

Striping Project to Traffic Limited for a total amount of \$148,522.51

under County Project No. 426641 – Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

<u>FUNDING</u>: The 2023 Nevada County Annual Striping Project will be funded by Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) and Highway User Tax Account (HUTA) funds and is budgeted in Road Maintenance for Fiscal Year 2023/24. There is no impact to the General Fund.

BACKGROUND: On February 28, 2023, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approved Resolution 23-081 to authorize the Purchasing Agent to solicit bids for the 2023 Nevada County Annual Striping Project. These bids were opened on April 11, 2023, and are listed below:

Bidder	Total Bid
Central Striping Service Sierra Traffic Markings Inc.	\$218,457.73 \$206,465.05
Specialized Pavement marking, LLC	\$195,943.48
Traffic Limited	\$135,020.46

Initial Engineer's Estimate \$218,079.00

It is recommended that the contract be awarded to the low bidder, Traffic Limited at the bid price of \$135,020.46, plus a 10% contingency of \$13,502.05 for a total amount of \$148,522.51. Work is planned to begin in September 2023.
