OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF ACCEPTANCE AND COMPLETION OF THE CONTRACT WITH BOBERG HARDWOOD FLOORS, INC., FOR THE NEVADA COUNTY GRASS VALLEY VETERANS HALL GYM FLOOR REPLACEMENT PROJECT WITH CONTRACT COSTS TOTALING \$160,000 AND DIRECTING THE CLERK OF THE BOARD TO RECORD THIS NOTICE IN ACCORDANCE WITH CIVIL CODE SECTION 9208

WHEREAS, construction documents were prepared and approved through Resolution 21-042 for the project known as the Nevada County Grass Valley Veterans Hall Gym Floor Replacement; and

WHEREAS, the County of Nevada entered into a Standard Public Works Contract with Boberg Hardwood Floors, Inc., (5951 Jetton Lane, Suite C3, Loomis, CA, 95650) through Resolution 21-132, totaling \$173,228 including a 10% contingency; and

WHEREAS, said Contract was for the Nevada County Grass Valley Veterans Hall Gym Floor Replacement in accordance with the plans and specifications; and

WHEREAS, said improvements were completed to the satisfaction of the Nevada County Chief Information Officer on June 23, 2021, with contract costs totaling \$160,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors:

1. Accepts the work as being completed.
2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to release the Bond for Labor and Materials on August 31, 2021 and the Bond of Faithful Performance on June 23, 2022.
3. Directs the Clerk of the Nevada County Board of Supervisors to record this notice in accordance with Civil Code Section 9208.
4. Directs the Auditor Controller to increase the Facilities Planning Assignment by \$13,228 to reinstate the unused Facilities Planning Assignment project funds back into the Assignment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Auditor-Controller is hereby authorized and directed to release and pay the 5% retention thirty-five (35) days after of the recording of the Notice of Completion, or no later than sixty (60) days after completion of the project as defined in PCC Sec. 7107, whichever occurs first, to assure that there are no Stop Payment notices filed against the project.
