SUBJECT: Resolution approving execution of Amendment No. 3 to the renewal contract with Restpadd Health Corp. for the provision of 24-hour locked acute psychiatric services for residents of Nevada County who meet criteria for 5150 placement to increase the maximum contract price from \$402,100 to \$404,180 (an increase of \$2,080) due to an increase in services in FY 19/20. (Purchase Order No. PESN3883; RES. 19-559; RES. 20-231)

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: These services are mandated. The contract is supported by Behavioral Health's 2011 Realignment funds for Managed Care, Medi-Cal reimbursement, and 1991 Realignment as needed for referred uninsured indigent clients. A budget amendment is not necessary in 19/20 and these expenses are within the 20/21 Behavioral Health budget; there are no general fund dollars required.

BACKGROUND:

On September 26, 2019, the Nevada County Purchasing Agent approved a contract with Restpadd Health Corp. per Purchase Order Number PESN3883 to provide 24-hour locked acute psychiatric services for Nevada County residents. On October 22, 2019, per Resolution 19-559, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors authorized the execution of Amendment No. 1, to the Contract, which increased the contract price from \$25,000 to \$125,000. A second amendment was authorized on June 23, 2020 per Resolution 20-231, again increasing the contract amount.

Restpadd Psychiatric Health Facility (inpatient) offers services to adults, 18 years and older. Contractor's focus is on patient's strengths with individualized treatment plans; promote

active family involvement and effective collaboration with patient's caregivers and support system.

Restpadd is a non-smoking, 16 bed acute care psychiatric inpatient treatment facility licensed by the State of California Department of Health Care Services. Admission is based on the medical necessity of patients who are unable to maintain and safely function at home or in the community. Restpadd provides multi-disciplinary evaluation, treatment, rapid stabilization, and coordinated discharge planning that encourages wellness and recovery.

The Parties desire to execute an Amendment No. 3 to this Contract to provide continued treatment on behalf of the Department of Behavioral Health's clients. This Amendment No. 3 increases the maximum contract price from \$402,100 to \$404,180 (an increase of \$2,080).

It is recommended that the Board approve this Amendment which allows continuation of essential, mandated services for medically necessary inpatient services to eligible residents of Nevada County who have a mental illness and /or emotional disturbances that require acute psychiatric hospitalization services.
