<u>SUBJECT</u>: Resolution approving Amendment No. 1 to the professional services contract between the County of Nevada and Common Purpose to amend the contract maximum from \$60,000 to \$140,000 and authorizing the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute the amendment.

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: Adopt the Resolution.

<u>FUNDING</u>: All services are funded through the State Local Community Corrections Account (AB109) and there is sufficient budget to cover the contract increase of \$80,000. No budget amendment required.

BACKGROUND:

The 2024-2025 CCP plan allocates monies for the purposes of providing recovery housing to Probation clients in fiscal year 2024-2025. The contract with Common Purpose for fiscal year 2024-2025, provides outpatient services and recovery housing in a family recovery environment where individuals are provided housing in a local residence and are required to participate in activities which develop self-sufficiency and decrease homelessness including performing house chores and maintenance responsibilities.

Recovery housing has become a well established part of substance use disorder treatment and is highly utilized by the Probation Department in service of our clients. Over the last few years recovery housing has become more heavily utilized by multiple county agencies such as Behavioral Health, Social Services and Child Welfare and has become vital to the model of substance use disorder treatment in Nevada County. Common Purpose has had the opportunity to expand beds within Nevada County by obtaining a new recovery residence. This contract expansion will provide more treatment opportunities for those suffering with substance use disorders for Nevada County Probation clients.
