SUBJECT: Resolution approving execution of Amendment No. 1 to the contract with Agnew Beck Consulting LLC to support homeless coalition work in the Tahoe Truckee region to increase the contract price from \$49,875 to \$75,000 (an increase of \$25,125). (PEST5252)

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: There is no additional cost to the county as \$25,000 to amend this contract was agreed to by Tahoe Forest Hospital District to continue the homeless coalition work in the Tahoe Truckee region. Original funding for this contract was supported through Health and Human Services Admin budget (\$25,000) and a revenue contract with the Town of Truckee for \$25,000.

BACKGROUND: On August 6, 2025, per Purchasing Order PEST5252, the Nevada County Purchasing Agent approved execution of the Professional Services Contract with Agnew Beck Consulting LLC to support homeless coalition work for a period of 6-months (with an option to extend) in the Tahoe Truckee region. This contract was initially funded through a partnership with Nevada County Health and Human Services and Town of Truckee funds that were committed to support this work. Tahoe Forest has contributed an additional \$25,000 to support the continued effort of this work.

The funding commitments made available to Nevada County represent a regional partnership effort of homeless coalition work now known as the Tahoe Truckee Homeless Action Coalition (TTHAC). The coalition work is focused on the implementation of a One Year Navigation Center Pilot that will provide sixteen (16) shelter beds (both interim and drop-in shelter beds), day services, and case management to individuals experiencing homelessness in the Truckee/North Tahoe region. The Pilot will be in Truckee and serve the needs of the North Tahoe and Truckee region. The project is a priority action of the *Tahoe Truckee Homeless Action Plan (2025)* and reflects a collaborative regional commitment to improve crisis response

services for people experiencing homelessness and reduce homelessness through case management and housing navigation services. Additional contracts for this project include the service provider for the One Year Navigation Center Pilot and additional revenue contracts to fund the service provider will come from the Behavioral Health Department and no longer from Health and Human Services Admin.

It is recommended that the Board approve this amendment as this effort represents a regional partnership among the Town of Truckee, Tahoe Forest Hospital District and Nevada County Health and Human Services.
