SUBJECT: Resolution approving Environmental Clearance and authorizing the Chair of the Board to sign the Invitation to Bid, and the Purchasing Agent to solicit bids for the 2026 Road Rehabilitation Project, County Project Number 450014 - Districts I, II, V.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached resolution.

FUNDING: The 2026 Road Rehabilitation Project is included in the annual Nevada County Capital Improvement Program (CIP) and will be appropriated as needed to the Road Engineering, PRD Darkhorse, and CSA 12 Zone 1 Adamson Road budgets upon contract execution. The County roadway portion will be funded using Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Act (RMRA) funds, there is no impact to the General Fund.

BACKGROUND: The Department of Public Works desires to perform road maintenance activities throughout Nevada County including portions of PRD Darkhorse and CSA 12 Zone 1 Adamson Road. Road maintenance activities include repair to potholes, micro-surfacing, chip sealing, and re-stripe of approximately 28 miles of County roadways as a routine maintenance and safety measure.

The project specifications and cost estimate for this project have all been completed. The engineer's estimate is \$2,650,000, plus a 10% contingency of \$265,000 for a total not-to-exceed contract of \$2,915,000.

The bid opening date will be set by the Director of Public Works, with the construction schedule to begin in July 2026.
