SUBJECT: Resolution approving execution of Amendment No. 1 to the renewal personal services contract with Granite Wellness Centers for the provision of perinatal and Non-Perinatal Outpatient Drug Free Treatment (ODF) and Intensive Outpatient Treatment (IOT) services for substance using pregnant and/or parenting women, men, and adolescents; comprehensive residential treatment program services for the recovery of alcohol/drug dependency; and substance abuse prevention and treatment services, to residents of Nevada County increasing the Maximum Contract Amount to \$1,973,284 (an increase of \$256,400), revising Exhibit "A" schedule of services to reflect change in staffing and revising Exhibit "B" Schedule of Charges and Payments to. (RES. 19-471)

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: Approve the attached Resolution.

<u>FUNDING</u>: Contract services are supported by: Federal SABG (Substance Abuse Block Grant) funds; 2011 Realignment; Community Based Transitional Housing (CBTH) Grant Funding; HRSA Rural Health Opioid Program Grant funds; Proposition 47 Grant funds; Court generated Statham funds; Drug Medi-Cal Federal reimbursement; Supportive and Therapeutic Options Program (STOP) funds and funds made available from Probation and Social Services Departments. A budget amendment will be included with the next County Wide Budget Amendment. There are no county general fund dollars required in the contract.

BACKGROUND:

Per Resolution 19-471, Granite Wellness Centers, is to provide services related to substance abuse prevention and treatment for Nevada County residents. The contract includes the following components:

Full spectrum of Perinatal and Non-Perinatal Services within the modalities of Outpatient Drug Free (ODF) Treatment and Intensive Outpatient (IOT) Treatment; Residential Treatment, Residential Crisis, Transitional and Withdrawal Management Programs; Prevention and Outpatient Treatment Programs; and Ancillary Services.

Under the proposed amendment, the Parties desire to increase the total amount of the Contract by \$256,400 to reflect the incorporation of additional funding for Recovery Residences, adolescent SUD services, flexible funds, and Interim Services.
