SUBJECT: Resolution accepting the California Secretary of State's Standard Agreement No. 25G30114 for Nevada County Elections, authorizing the reappropriation and continued use of remaining Voting System Replacement Grant funds originally awarded under Standard Agreement No. 18G30129.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the Resolution

FUNDING: Funding for this item is provided through California Secretary of State Standard Agreement No. 25G30114, which reappropriates the remaining unused balance of Voting System Replacement Grant funds originally awarded under Standard Agreement No. 18G30129. The total amount available under the new agreement is \$88,040.91, subject to a three-to-one (75%) reimbursement structure and has been included in the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Elections budget.

BACKGROUND: The Voting System Replacement Grant is administered by the California Secretary of State pursuant to Assembly Bill 1824 (Stats. 2018) and Assembly Bill 74 (Stats. 2019), and California Elections Code sections 19400 and 19402.

On February 12, 2019, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 19-052 accepting the original grant award in the amount of \$449,500.00. Subsequent amendments expanded the maximum grant amount and extended expenditure deadlines, including Resolution No. 20-038 (February 11, 2020) and Resolution No. 22-152.

On January 14, 2025, the Board adopted Resolution No. 25-021 extending the deadline for reimbursement claims to August 31, 2026, for counties with remaining unused funds. As required by the Secretary of State, the unexpended balance of \$88,040.91 must be accessed through a new standard agreement, Standard Agreement No. 25G30114.

Adoption of the proposed resolution does not authorize new funding. Rather, it allows the Elections Department to continue utilizing previously approved grant funds under updated contractual terms and timelines established by the Secretary of State.
