### **RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF A GRANT CLOSE-OUT AGREEMENT AND RELEASE OF OBLIGATION FROM THE GRANT AGREEMENT EXECUTED BETWEEN NEVADA COUNTY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AND ADVOCATES FOR HUMAN POTENTIAL THROUGH RESOLUTION 22-208 FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES CRISIS CARE MOBILE UNITS GRANT**

WHEREAS, the Crisis Care Mobile Unit (CCMU) Grant administered through Advocates for Human Potential, Inc. was made available to the Nevada County Behavioral Health Department; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of CCMU was to provide funding to behavioral health authorities to implement, enhance, and support crisis care mobile units through infrastructure development; and

WHEREAS, the monies awarded to Nevada County were utilized to expand mobile crisis services through additional staffing and infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the grant contract term ended on June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Advocates for Human Potential has requested a grant close out letter entitled Subcontractor Release and Assignment as a release of obligations be signed by the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Release and Assignment Agreement by and between the County and Advocates for Human Potential, Inc. (AHP) Crisis Care Mobile Unit (CCMU) pertaining to the official close out and release of obligations from the initial grant agreement, be and hereby is approved, and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute the Release on behalf of the County of Nevada.
