SUBJECT: Resolution amending Resolution No. 21-516 to reflect correction of the program award ceiling amount of \$8,000,000.00 that is listed in the statute pertaining to the award of Round 3 of the Transitional Housing Program. (RES. 21-516)

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: This is a State of California Allocation Acceptance for \$8,000.00 in grant money for Nevada County of the total \$8 million program funding for counties overall. There are no county general fund dollars required in the Agreement.

BACKGROUND: Pursuant to item 2240-102-0001 of Section 2.00 of the Budget Act of 2021 (Chapter 69 of the Statutes of 2021) and Chapter 11.7 (commencing with Section 50807) of Part 2 of Division 31 of the Health and Safety Code, the Department of Housing and Community Development shall allocate \$8 million in funding to counties for the purpose of housing stability to help young adults 18 to 25 years secure and maintain housing, with priority given to young adults formerly in the foster care or probation systems. Nevada County was awarded \$8,000 pursuant to the Transitional Housing Program Allocation Acceptance Round 3.

Per Resolution 21-516, the Board of Supervisors approved participation in Round 3 of the Transitional Housing Program Application for Round 3 funds. However, after the Resolution submission, HCD provided feedback that the program amount listed in the first Whereas of Resolution 21-516 needed to be corrected to reflect a dollar amount per HCD

legal review. The original amount listed was \$8,000 and now an award ceiling of \$8,000,000 is being added through this amendment.

It is recommended that the Board approve this amendment to Resolution 21-516 as the funds will help young adults to secure and maintain housing.
