## **OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA**

### **RESOLUTION ACCEPTING STATE AND FEDERAL FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,678,028.46 FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF COVID-19 RELATED RESPONSE AND RECOVERY COSTS.**

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2020, March 4, 2020, and March 5, 2020, the federal, state and local health agencies declared state of emergencies for the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19); and

WHEREAS, during the ensuing months and years, Nevada County expended significant funds to protect its workforce, citizens, and general public by operating a vaccination clinic, administering the Great Plates program, and through temporary emergency protective measures; and

WHEREAS, the County of Nevada submitted reimbursement claims through the State Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for a total of \$1,723,286; and

WHEREAS, FEMA and CalOES accepted the claims and reimbursed the County of Nevada \$1,678,028.46 for its vaccination clinic, Great Plates program, and temporary emergency measures directly related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the recovery and reimbursement funding from FEMA and CalOES in the amount of \$1,678,028.46 related to the vaccination clinic, Great Plates program, and temporary emergency measures directly related to the COVID-19 pandemic is hereby accepted.
