SUBJECT: A Resolution amending Resolution No. 21-486 to reflect correction of the program award ceiling amount that is listed in the statute pertaining to the award of County Allocation Award under the Housing Navigators Program.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: This is a State of California Allocation Acceptance application for \$5,915.00. There is no impact on the General Fund.

BACKGROUND: Pursuant to Health and Safety Code Ch. 11.8 Section 50811 the Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has allocated funding to counties for the support of housing navigators to help young adults aged 18 years and up to 21 years secure and maintain housing, with priority given to young adults in the foster care system. The County may use the funding to provide housing navigation services directly or through a contract with other housing assistance programs in the County.

It is recommended that the Board approve this item as it will assist young adults with their pursuits of locating available housing and overcoming barriers to locating housing.

Per Resolution 21-486, the Board of Supervisors approved participation in Housing Navigators Program funds. However, after the Resolution submission, HCD provided feedback that the program amount listed in the first Whereas of Resolution 21-486 needed to be corrected to reflect a dollar amount per HCD legal review. The original amount listed

was \$5,915 and now an award ceiling of \$5,000,000 is being added through this amendment.

It is recommended that the Board approve this amendment to Resolution 21-486 as the funds will help young adults to secure and maintain housing.
