I just received a mailer from Rise of Grass Valley with a postcard attached.

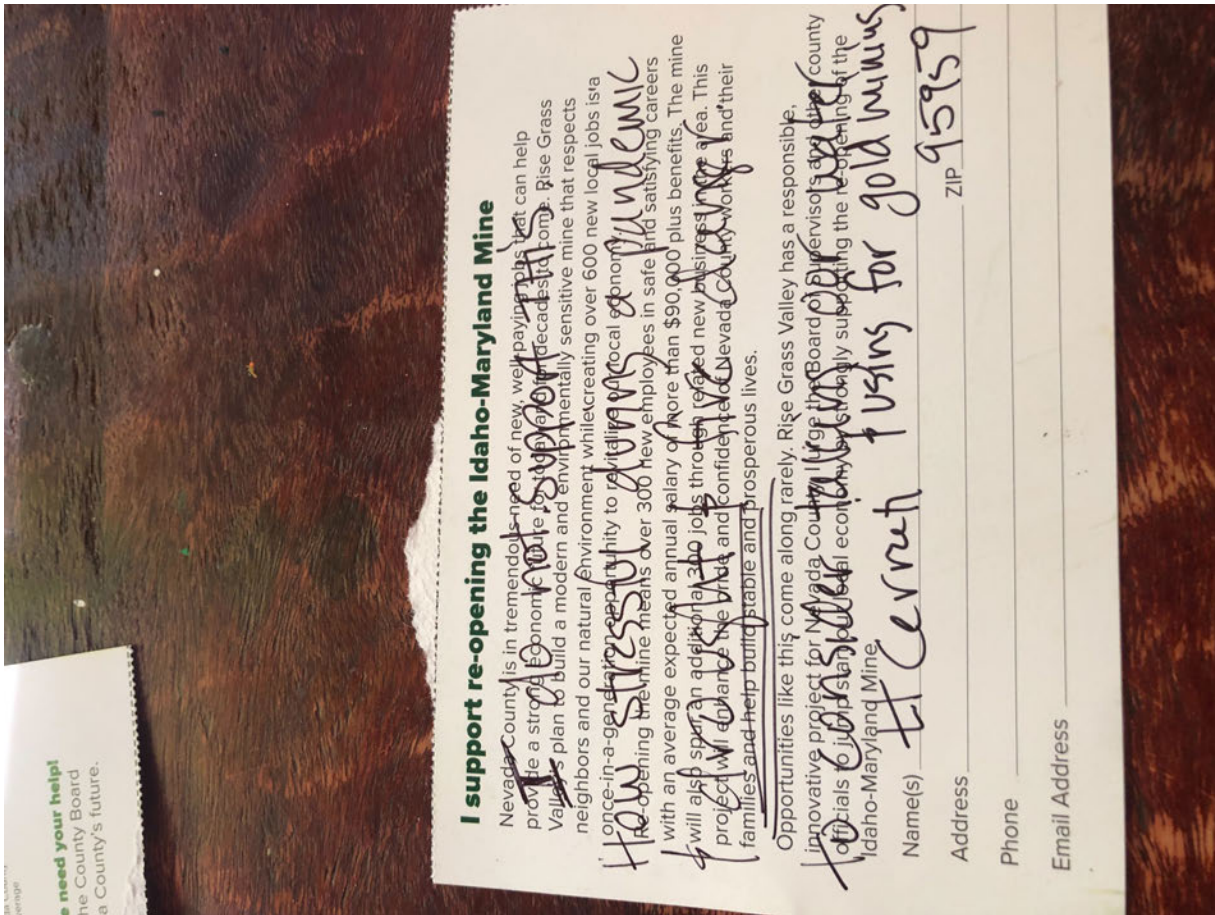
Due to environmental impacts and relatively small tax dollars received for mining gold I do NOT Support reopening the Idaho-Maryland Mine.
