SUBJECT: Discretionary appointments to Special District Boards

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution approving discretionary appointments to Special

District Boards

FUNDING: None.

BACKGROUND: On September 13, 2022, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 22-477, appointing candidates who filed declarations of candidacy and faced no opposition to Special District Boards. Elections Code section 10515 provides that the Board may appoint any remaining vacancies. The following districts with remaining vacancies were notified by the Clerk of the Board that the Board of Supervisors was seeking qualified applicants to fill the upcoming vacancies: Lake of the Pines Ranchos Community Service District, Mystic Mine Road Community Service District, Peardale-Chicago Park Fire Protection District and Rough and Ready Fire Protection District.

An advertisement was placed in The Union newspaper on September 22, 2022, advertising vacancies in said districts and placed on the County website and County bulletin boards.

Applications were not received for the positions on the Lake of the Pines Ranchos Community Service District, Mystic Mine Road Community Service District or the Rough and Ready Fire Protection District. Two applications were received for positions on the Peardale-Chicago Park Fire Protection District. Pursuant to Exhibit B of Resolution 22-477 appointments will also be made to the Donner Summit Public Utility District.

Please consider adoption of the Resolution approving discretionary appointments to Special District Boards.
