

RESOLUTION No. 25-150

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH HDL COMPANIES (HDL) IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$70,000 FOR SALES AND USE TAX AUDIT AND INFORMATIONAL SERVICES FOR RECOVERY OF MISALLOCATED SALES AND USE TAX FOR THE COUNTY OF NEVADA FOR THE CONTRACT TERM OF JULY 1, 2025, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2027

WHEREAS, sales and use tax audit services help to ensure that taxes are being appropriately remitted to the County and that our sales tax revenue projections are as accurate as possible; and

WHEREAS, engaging a consultant to perform this complex analysis is the most cost effective option; and

WHEREAS, a request for proposal (RFP) was issued on December 19, 2024, to competitively solicit interested firms; and


WHEREAS, two proposals were received and scored by a committee consisting of representatives from the Treasurer Tax-Collector, Auditor-Controller, County Executive Office, and Clerk of the Board Office; and

WHEREAS, HdL Companies was the highest-scored proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, hereby:

- 1) Approves the contract with HdL Companies in substantially the form attached in the amount of \$70,000 for the term of July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2027, and authorizes the Purchasing agent to execute the contract on behalf of the County of Nevada.
- 2) Authorizes the Purchasing Agent to sign the contract and encumber the funds associated with the above professional services contract.
