SUBJECT: Resolution rescinding Resolution 24-163 and approving a revised amendment to the agreement with Partnership HealthPlan of California (RES. 23-572) to replace Attachments B and D to add in missing billing information and Public Health Clinic medical specialties under the current evergreen Agreement for the term commencing January 1, 2024, and in effect until terminated.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: There is no fiscal impact resulting from the proposed Resolution. Through the previously approved Agreement, the Public Health Department is able to receive reimbursement from Partnership HealthPlan of California (PHC) when it provides Public Health Services to beneficiaries. Public Health receives reimbursement from Partnership at the established rate. There are no county general fund dollars required in the Agreement.

BACKGROUND: On December 5, 2023, per Resolution 23-572, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approved execution of a Health Care Services Agreement (“Agreement”) with Partnership HealthPlan of California for the provision of health care services and reimbursement of covered services provided to plan members. On April 23, 2024 per Resolution 24-163 the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approved Amendment No. 1 to the Healthcare Services Agreement between Partnership Health Plan of California to include missing critical billing information including Public Health’s service addresses, Billing National Provider Identification (NPI), Tax Identification Number, and medical specialties. However, PHC did not sign the original amendment and notified Public Health that the amendment did not exactly match the most current template language approved by the Department of Health Care Services. PHC provided an updated template for the amendment which is now requiring Board approval with this Resolution. Resolution 24-163 will be rescinded, and the attached Amendment will be executed.

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve this revised Amendment that will replace Attachments B and D to add in missing billing information and Public Health Clinic medical specialties. No other changes are being made to the Agreement.
