OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING ACCEPTANCE OF COMMUNITY CARE EXPANSION (CCE) PRESERVATION PROGRAM FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$418,403 AND AUTHORIZING THE NEVADA COUNTY HOUSING AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DIRECTOR TO SIGN AND EXECUTE THE PROGRAM FUNDING AGREEMENT TO PROMOTE PRESERVATION OF ADULT AND SENIOR CARE FACILITIES IN NEVADA COUNTY SERVING LOW-INCOME RESIDENTS

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2021, Governor Gavin Newsom signed AB 172 which created the Community Care Expansion (CCE) Preservation program aimed at preserving adult and senior care facilities that serve Supplemental Security Income/State Supplementary Payment (SSP) and Cash assistance Program for Immigrants (CAPI) applicants as a diversion from homelessness for seniors and persons with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, The California Department of Social Services, through its contractor HORNE, ("Department") issued a Request for Applications, dated January 31, 2022 ("RFA"), for the Community Care Expansion (CCE) Preservation Program ("Program"); and

WHEREAS, The Department issued the RFA for Program grant funds pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code, Division 9, Part 6, commencing with section 18999.97; and

WHEREAS, The County of Nevada ("Applicant"), applied for Program grant funds by submitting an application for Program funds ("Application") to the Department for review and consideration; and

WHEREAS, The Program is intended to preserve and avoid closure of licensed residential adult and senior care facilities that serve applicants and recipients of Supplemental Security Income/State Supplementary Payment and Cash Assistance Program for Immigrants (CAPI); and

WHEREAS, The County of Nevada was awarded a total of \$418,403 for the purpose of funding operating subsidy payments and capital projects addressing critical repairs or upgrades with the goal of preventing closures and preserving beds in existing facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada accepts CCE Preservation funding in the total amount of \$418,403 and authorizes the Nevada County Housing and Community Services Director to sign and execute the Program Funding Agreement to support preservation and to prevent closures of adult and senior residential care facilities serving low-income residents.
