

PUBLIC HEARING REQUIREMENT


- As required by California Government Code Section 12747 (b)-(d), agencies are required to conduct a public hearing for the purpose of reviewing the draft Community Action Plan (CAP).
 - All testimony presented during the public hearing shall be considered for the final CAP
 - Agencies shall indicate whether or not the concerns expressed have been addressed in the plan
 - The draft CAP must be made available for public review and comment for a minimum of 30 days in advance of the public hearing (posting date was May 2, 2025)
 - Notice of the hearing and comment period must be published at least 15 calendar days prior to the public hearing (posting date was May 2, 2025)

COMMUNITY NEEDS ASSESSMENT

- Requirement for Community Service Block Grant (CSBG) Organizational Standards
 - Information collected directly from lowincome individuals
 - Information gathered from key sectors in the community (CBOs, faith-based organizations, private sector and education)
 - Used to inform the two-year Community Action Plan
