SUBJECT: Resolution amending Resolution 21-402, to include the required

California Department of Insurance language for the Workers'

Compensation Insurance Fraud Grant Funds

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the Resolution amending Resolution No. 21-402 to include the California Department of Insurance required language regarding the funding source and responsibility of liability.

FUNDING:

Funding is included in the District Attorney FY 2021/22 budget. There is no impact on the General Fund.

BACKGROUND:

Under the direction of the Insurance Commissioner of the State of California, the California Department of Insurance administers the grant program and the distribution of funds for enhanced investigation and prosecution of workers' compensation insurance fraud by local district attorneys. The authority is granted to the Insurance Commissioner under Section 1872.83 of the California Insurance Code.

This is the ninth year the District Attorney's Office has been awarded this grant. A request for application was submitted to the Insurance Commission in April 2021. The District Attorney's Office presented the Nevada County Plan to the California Department of Insurance Worker's Compensation Grant Review Panel on June 2, 2021. Based on the Review Panel's evaluation of each county Plan, the Panel forwards funding recommendations to the Commissioner. The recommendation of the review panel to the Insurance Commissioner was reviewed and approved to include Nevada County. The Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 21.402 on September 14, 2021 accepting the California Department of Insurance Workers' Compensation Insurance Fraud Grant Funds in the amount of \$96,720.00. The funds are available to 36 District Attorney Offices in the State of California including Nevada County.
