SUBJECT: Resolution approving execution of Amendment #1 to Professional Services Agreement with Nevada-Sierra Connecting Point Public Authority to operate a Medi-Cal Health Enrollment Navigators Project (Navigators Project) in Nevada County to extend the contract termination date from December 31, 2021 to June 30, 2022 and amend Exhibit "B" Schedule of Charges and Payments to reflect the change in allocation time period and a term extension. (RES 20-429)

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: Contract services will be funded by Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) Medi-Cal Health Enrollment Navigators Project dollars. The total maximum contract price shall remain unchanged, but the fiscal year contract amounts are adjusted to reflect \$85,092 for the contract term of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021 and \$157,908 for the contract term of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. A budget amendment is not necessary and there are no County General Fund dollars required in the Agreement.

BACKGROUND: On October 13, 2020, per Resolution 20-429, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approved the execution of the Professional Services Agreement with Nevada-Sierra Connecting Point Public Authority to provide enrollment and retention of Medi-Cal services for targeted populations including: persons with mental health disorder needs; persons with substance use disorder needs; persons who are homeless; aged persons; persons with other disabilities; persons with limited English proficiency; low-wage workers and their families or dependents; uninsured children and youth formerly enrolled in Medi-Cal; and persons who are currently in county jails, in state prison, on state parole, on county probation, or under post release community supervision

It is recommended that the Board approve Amendment #1 as it will provide services and support to targeted populations in Nevada County ensuring enrollment and retention in Medi-Cal services.
