
NCBH, together with key partner agencies, provides housing to over 250 clients throughout the community

Ownership models vary


Level of staffing support also varies

#### **Behavioral Health Housing Supports**




#### **Spectrum of Housing Options**

Housing is a top priority for the community

- Priority for the Board of Supervisors
- In most recent Mental Health Services Act mental health needs assessment, it was a top concern
- Housing is a top concern for the state as well
  lots of new resources to support expanded options

Opportunity to house six more clients

Unexpected revenues from Mental Health Services Act this year

Utilize AMI Housing, our existing contractor

Implement a subsidized and staffed housing option for clients who need significant support

Staff will be available at all hours if neighbors have concerns

Who will live there?

People who are members of our community who have serious mental illness

Long term clients who are stable but who need more support to be successful

Helps keep people from negative outcomes like hospitalizations, homelessness or jail
