SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing execution of an agreement with the

California Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways for reimbursement of boating safety enforcement

costs for fiscal year 2022/2023

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution

FUNDING: This discretionary funding is for FY 22/23 and will impact the Sheriff's Operations Budget in the amount of \$96,674. There will be no impact to the General Fund.

BACKGROUND: The attached Resolution and Agreement are required by the California Department of Boating and Waterways for participation in the state assisted programs for boating safety and enforcement. It provides a maximum of \$96,674 in funding to reimburse the Sheriff's Office for costs related to the Boating Safety and Enforcement Program for FY 2022-2023. The application for this funding was approved by the Board of Supervisors via Resolution 21-468.

The Sheriff's Office has participated in this enforcement program for over forty years. The Program allows the Sheriff's Office to assign specially trained officers to patrol the county's waterways throughout the summer months when the number of visitors to the area is at its peak. Funds received from this program and a portion of the personal property tax assessed on boats pay the cost of deputies' salaries and benefits, boats, training, maintenance, and other program related costs. Without this financial support, there would be only emergency enforcement of watercraft law or boating safety regulations on our county lakes.
