**SUBJECT:** Resolution to Award the Project for the 2022 High Friction Surface Treatment Project to Q&D Construction, LLC., for a Total Amount of \$1,511,399.87 – All Districts

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached Resolution.

**FUNDING:** The project is budgeted in Fiscal Year 2021/22 Road Engineering budget and is in the current Department of Public Works Capital Improvement Plan (CIP). Funding is provided by the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP). There is no impact to the County's General Fund.

**BACKGROUND:** On March 22, 2022, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 22-136 approving the bid documents for this project and authorized the Nevada County Purchasing Division to advertise for bids. The bids were opened on April 20, 2022, and are listed below:

There was a minor bid irregularity on the bid for Q&D Construction, LLC., Their item total for bid item 6. "Paint Centerline (4-inch Caltrans Detail 21/22)" was \$12,140.12. However, the price should have been (607 LF) (\$20/LF) = \$12,140.00. The total of bid is actually \$1,373,999.88, which is still the lowest bid as shown above.

It is recommended that the contract be awarded to the low bidder, Q&D Construction, LLC., at the bid price of \$1,373,999.88.

The amount to be encumbered for this work is \$1,373,999.88, plus a 10% contingency of \$137,399.99 for a total of \$1,511,399.87. Work is scheduled to begin in summer 2022, and be completed within 50 working days, as allowed for in the Contract.

Although Resolution 22-136 also authorized the Director of Public Works to award and execute the Contract, by this new Resolution, award will be authorized directly by the Board of Supervisors, and this Contract will be executed directly by the Chair of the Board of Supervisors.
