## **BACKGROUND:**

The Local Planning Council (LPC) Child Care and Development for Nevada County is a formal committee of the County with the purpose to identify child care and development services priorities, to enhance cooperation among children services, interest groups and agencies, to develop a strategic long-range plan for a broad spectrum of child care and development services, and to advocate the support of child care and development services at the local, state and federal levels of government. The Council is prohibited from engaging in the provision of direct services. The Local Child Care and Development Planning Council was established on June 4, 1991 by Res. 91-311 and was designated as the Local Child Care and Development Planning Council as required by AB 1542 (Res. 98-12). This Council consists of 10 members: five appointed by the Board of Supervisors and five appointed by the Nevada County Superintendent of Schools.

Subsequently, LPC has been requested by the Department of Education to identify local priorities for new childcare funding by Zip Code areas that must be approved by the Board of Supervisors and the Superintendent of Schools. These priorities areas are then submitted to the Department of Education to prioritize funding requests for local childcare services as funds become available. Attached includes a letter from LPC dated May 16, 2022 requesting the Board accept and approve Zip Code Priorities for Early Care and Education in Nevada County as prepared by the Local Planning Council (LPC) Child Care Development for Nevada County, and authorizing the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute the LPC County Priorities Report Form. Should the Board approve and authorize the Chair to sign the attached Form, the Superindent of Schools will then be requested to sign before being submitted to the state.
