

GOALS:

- · Increase youth employment
- · Develop career pathways
- Strengthen local capacity to address key areas of food insecurity, climate, and COVID-19 recovery
- 1.7 million dollars serving youth and our community!



WHO WILL THIS PROGRAM SERVE?

Participants must be between 16-30 years of age.

Priority given to youth who:

- May have difficulty finding employment
- Are low-income
- Are unemployed and/or out of school
- Are or were justice-involved
- Are in or transitioning from foster care
- Are engaged with the mental health or substance recovery system

Short-term Opportunities:


- Summer camp

CONNECTING POINT

- Recruit, train and develop approximately 50 youth positions
- Provide training for all participants (BFFY and CP)
- Create and maintain relationships with nonprofits and local government in order to provide valuable work experience to youth
- Provide career counseling and coaching
- Navigation to reduce the barriers to employment
