Nevada County to fund programs and projects that respond to the negative economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic and are designed to increase **resiliency**, support **recovery**, and provide **relief**.

ROUND 2: Guidelines and format were consistent with the first, with the exception being that the RFP focused eligibility specifically on **entities providing small business support services who had not received a previous Community Resiliency grant**.

 - Respond to the **negative economic impac**t
 - Provide **community benefits**
 - Leverage partnerships and funding
 - **Demonstrate capacity** to manage the grant \bigcirc






