**SUBJECT:** Resolution approving a contract with Shona Torgrimson d/b/a

Helping Hands Nurturing Center for Nurturing Parenting

Program (NPP) in the maximum amount of \$81,400 for the term

of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached Resolution.

**<u>FUNDING</u>**: Funding for these services is provided through a grant allocation from CalWORKs Single Allocation funds and Department Realignment funds. Services are within the Department's FY 2022/23 budget and there are no county general funds required in the Agreement.

## **BACKGROUND:**

CalWORKs is a program that gives cash aid and services to eligible families for a limited amount of time. The program provides limited cash and support for basic needs such as housing, food, utilities, clothing or medical care. The goal is to assist the families in achieving self-sufficiency. Parenting sessions and participation in supportive group sessions assist in strengthening the families ability to achieve this goal.

Per this Agreement, the Contractor will provide Nurturing Parenting Program (NPP) services utilizing The Nurturing Parenting Program (NPP) curriculum that coordinates health and social services for at-risk families referred by CalWORKs. parenting sessions, and/or group services; utilizing the NPP best practices; use strength based and multi-disciplinary approaches; and focus on family stability and self-sufficiency.

It is recommended that the Board approve this Agreement which provides necessary services and supports to families receiving Nurturing Parenting Program services as referred to by CalWORKs Services to improve outcomes for Nevada County children and families.
