The amendment of parking prohibitions on Dog Bar Road, Pleasant Valley Road and Soda Springs Road, and the addition of parking prohibitions on Boreal Ridge Road, Coyote Street, Donner Lake Road, Maybert Road, Relief Hill Road and Washington Road are needed to enable enforcement of appropriate parking restrictions to deter illegal parking. In compiling these changes, input was considered from California Highway Patrol, Nevada County Sheriff's Office, Placer County, the Town of Washington Fire Department and Nevada County Staff.

The Board Chair may place reasonable restrictions on the time allowed to any person to comment on these matters. Any person commenting on behalf of an organization or group who wishes additional time must have a written statement signed by an officer of that organization stating that he/she is authorized to speak on behalf of that body, and that he/she is relaying the majority thinking thereof.
