## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

> RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF A RENEWAL CONTRACT WITH NEVADA COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS (NCSOS) RELATED TO THE PROVISION OF LATINO OUTREACH SERVICES THROUGH THE GRASS VALLEY FAMILY RESOURCE CENTER AS A COMPONENT OF THE COUNTY'S MHSA PREVENTION AND EARLY INTERVENTION (PEI) PLAN IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$88,706 FOR FY 2022/23

WHEREAS, the County of Nevada, Behavioral Health Department wishes to renew the contract with the Nevada County Superintendent of Schools for the provision of Latino Outreach Services through the Grass Valley Resource Center as a component of the County's Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) Plan; and

WHEREAS, PEI seeks to reach unserved or underserved populations including members of ethnically/racially diverse segments and to address disparities in access to mental health services; and

WHEREAS, the targeted focus of services under this Agreement is the Latino population, a quickly growing population in Nevada County, who has limited access to Spanish speaking resources, especially mental health services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Professional Services Contract by and between the County and Nevada County Superintendent of Schools related to the provision of Latino Outreach and Engagement Mental Health Services including the provision of psycho-educational meetings in the maximum amount of $\$ 88,706$ for the term of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023, be and hereby is approved in substantially the form attached hereto, and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to execute the Contract on behalf of the County of Nevada. This contract is contingent upon the adoption of the FY 22/23 County Budget which is scheduled for adoption on June 28, 2022.
