

# ORDINANCE No. 2512

# OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

#### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION G-IV 3.A.8 OF ARTICLE 3.A OF CHAPTER IV OF THE NEVADA COUNTY GENERAL CODE PERTAINING TO PARKING PROHIBITIONS – DISTRICTS I, II, IV, and V

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

#### SECTION I:

That the Amendment of parking prohibitions on Dog Bar Road, Pleasant Valley Road and Soda Springs Road, and the addition of parking prohibitions on Boreal Ridge Road, Coyote Street, Donner Lake Road, Donner Pass Road, Maybert Road, Relief Hill Road and Washington Road be approved based on the following findings:

A. Pursuant to Article XI, Section 7 of the California Constitution, the County of Nevada ("County") may adopt and enforce ordinances and regulations not in conflict with general laws to protect and promote the public health, safety, and welfare of its residents; and

B. Pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 22507.5, the County may by ordinance, prohibit or restrict parking or standing of vehicles on certain streets or highways, and said ordinance will become effective after the legislative body holds a public hearing, with proper notice; and

C. Dog Bar Road, Pleasant Valley Road, Soda Springs Road, Boreal Ridge Road, Coyote Street, Donner Lake Road, Donner Pass Road, Maybert Road, Relief Hill Road and Washington Road are County maintained roadways; and

D. The County has the authority to install signs within its right of way and to enact parking restrictions as needed pursuant California Vehicle Code section 22507; and

E. That the Ordinance Amendment is needed to enable enforcement of appropriate parking restrictions to deter illegal parking; and

F. In compiling this Amendment, input was considered from California Highway Patrol, Nevada County Sheriff's Office, Placer County, the Town of Washington Fire Department and Nevada County Staff.

#### **SECTION II**:

Section 3.A.8 of Article 3.A of Chapter IV of the Nevada County General Code is hereby replaced in its entirety as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

#### SECTION III:

Severability. If any provision of this Article or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this Article, including the application of such part or provision to other circumstances shall not be affected thereby and shall continue in full force and effect. To this end, provisions of this Article are severable. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase hereof irrespective of the fact that any one (1) or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases be held unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable.

#### **SECTION IV:**

This Ordinance shall be passed and adopted immediately after notice and a public hearing as required by statute, and shall take effect and be in force at the expiration of thirty (30) days from and after its passage, and shall become operative on the 15th day of August 2022, and, before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage a summary shall be published once, with the names of the Supervisors voting for and against same in the Union, and in the Sierra Sun, newspapers of general circulation printed and published in the County of Nevada.

## EXHIBIT A

### Sec. G-IV 3.A.8 Parking Prohibitions

A. The Director of the Department of Public Works of the County of Nevada is hereby authorized and instructed to erect or cause to be erected, appropriate signs on various County roads and highways described in Section G-IV 3.A.7, giving notice of the prohibition of parking as declared and established by this Section.

B. No vehicle shall be parked upon the County right-of-way for Boreal Ridge Road for 0.2 miles beginning at the Interstate 80 West off-ramp from November first through April thirtieth; vehicles parked upon County right-of-way during this period will be towed away at owner's expense. At all other times, no vehicle shall be parked at any time in designated no parking zones upon the County right-of-way for Boreal Ridge Road for 0.2 miles beginning at the Interstate 80 West off-ramp.

C. No vehicle shall be parked at any time upon the paved roadway, and in designated no parking zones upon the County right-of-way, and between 10p.m.-5a.m. where indicated by "NO PARKING 10p.m.-5a.m." signs, on Coyote Street from North Bloomfield-Graniteville Road 0.528 miles south to the Nevada City limit.

D. No vehicle shall be parked at any time upon the traveled portion of Dog Bar Road from the bridge crossing Bear River to Magnolia Road. No vehicle shall be parked at any time in designated no parking zones upon the County right-of-way for Dog Bar Road from the bridge crossing Bear River to Magnolia Road.

E. No vehicle shall be parked upon the County right-of-way for Donner Lake Road for 0.05 miles from Billy Mack Road to the Interstate 80 West off-ramp from November first through April thirtieth; vehicles parked upon County right-of-way during this period will be towed away at owner's expense. At all other times, no vehicle shall be parked at any time in designated no parking zones upon the County right-of-way for Donner Lake Road for 0.05 miles from Billy Mack Road to the Interstate West 80 off-ramp.

F. No vehicle shall be parked at any time upon the traveled way of Donner Pass Road from the Interstate 80 West off-ramp to the town limit of the Town of Truckee.

G. No vehicle shall be parked at any time in designated no parking zones upon the County right-of-way for Maybert Road from Washington Road 2.93 miles east to the Canyon Creek Bridge.

H. No vehicle shall be parked at any time upon the traversed portion of Newtown Road from State Highway 49 to 500 feet southwest on Newtown Road.

I. No vehicle shall be parked at any time upon County right-of-way in designated no parking zones on North Bloomfield-Graniteville Road, both sides of the Edwards Crossing Bridge.

J. No vehicle shall be parked at any time upon the County right-of-way in designated no parking zones, and between 10p.m.-5a.m. where indicated by "NO PARKING 10p.m.-5a.m." signs, on Old Downieville Highway from Cedro Road to the Nevada City limit and Champion Road from Newtown Road to Old Downieville Highway. K. No vehicle shall be parked at any time in designated no parking zones upon the County right-of-way for Pleasant Valley Road from 2,500 feet south of the Yuba River Bridge on

Pleasant Valley Road at the South Yuba State Park to 1,500 feet north of the Yuba River Bridge on Pleasant Valley Road at the South Yuba State Park.

L. No vehicle shall be parked at any time upon County right-of-way in designated no parking zones on Purdon Road, both sides of Purdon Bridge.

M. No vehicle shall be parked at any time in designated no parking zones on the County right-of-way for Relief Hill Road from Gaston Road 0.466 miles west to the end of pavement.

N. No vehicle shall be parked at any time upon the traveled way of the Soda Springs Road from Donner Pass Road thence southerly to the Nevada-Placer County boundary.

O. No vehicle shall be parked between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. on school days upon the County right-of-way on Via Vista between Ridge Road and 200 feet east of its intersection with Echo Ridge Drive.

P. No vehicle shall be parked at any time in designated no parking zones upon the County right-of-way for Washington Road from Maybert Road to 1,500 feet west of the South Yuba River Bridge on Washington Road."
