AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 13.9 OF CHAPTER II OF THE NEVADA COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE REGARDING GRAND JURY COMPENSATION AND MILEAGE

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I:

Findings and Declarations

- A. Pursuant to Article XI, section 7 of the California Constitution, the County of Nevada ("County") may adopt and enforce ordinances and regulations not in conflict with general laws to protect and promote the public health, safety, and welfare of its residents.
- B. Article 13.9 subsections A and C of Chapter II of the County of Nevada Administrative Code are amended to retitle the role of "Secretary" to "Full Panel Recorder" and add the title of "Business Manager" due to an expansion in responsibilities supporting the work of the Grand Jury.
- C. Article 13.9 subsection A of Chapter II of the County of Nevada Administrative Code is amended to read that in addition to the Foreperson, the Business Manager may be designated to establish mileage for purposes of compensation with the County of Nevada's Auditor's Office.
- D. Article 13.9 subsection B of Chapter II of the County of Nevada Administrative Code is amended to clarify specific types and quantity of meetings which are eligible for reimbursement.
- E. Other amendments to this Article are part of an ongoing effort to update clarification and formatting of the Nevada County Codes. Those changes are not substantive.

SECTION II:

Section A-II Article 13.9 of the Nevada County Administrative Code is hereby revised to read as shown in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

SECTION III:

Severability. If any provision of this Article or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this Article, including the application of such part or provision to other circumstances shall not be affected thereby and shall continue in full force and effect. To this end, provisions of this Article are severable. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase hereof irrespective of the fact that any one (1) or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be held unconstitutional, invalid or unenforceable.

SECTION IV:

This Ordinance shall be passed and adopted immediately after notice and a public hearing as required by statute, and shall take effect and be in force at the expiration of thirty (30) after its passage, and shall become operative on the 22nd day of September 2022, and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, a summary shall be published once, with the names of Supervisors voting for and against same in the Union, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Nevada.
