## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF A RENEWAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN NEVADA COUNTY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT AND NEVADA COUNTY SPECIAL EDUCATION LOCAL PLAN AREA (SELPA) PERTAINING TO THE DELIVERY OF EDUCATIONALLY RELATED MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES (ERMHS) FOR STUDENTS IN WESTERN NEVADA COUNTY SCHOOLS WHO ARE IDENTIFIED AS HAVING A MENTAL HEALTH NEED IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$65,000 FOR FY 2022/23

WHEREAS, the State of California is mandated by the federal government to provide services to special education pupils, including mental health assessments and the provision of necessary mental health related services as identified in a student's Individualized Education Program (IEP); and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County SELPA has identified a continuing need for specialty mental health services for pupils within their jurisdiction and the Nevada County Behavioral Health Department is agreeing to provide such services; and

WHEREAS, the State distributes funding to schools to help pay for mental health services to special education pupils and Nevada County SELPA is agreeing to reimburse Behavioral Health for necessary mental health services provided to eligible students.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Agreement by and between the County and Nevada County Special Education Local Plan Area pertaining to the delivery of Educationally Related Mental Health Services (ERMHS) for special education pupils as identified in the student's IEP for the term of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023, in the maximum payable amount of \$65,000 be and hereby is approved in substantially the form attached hereto, and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the County of Nevada.
