BACKGROUND: On February 10, 2022 Assembly Member James Ramos, co-sponsored by Assembly Member Megan Dahle, introduced Assembly Concurrent Resolution 137 promoting California Native American Day and the California Indian Cultural Awareness Conference. Currently the resolution is being considered and expected to pass the Senate Rules Committee. The historical and cultural significance to our region and California cannot be underestimated. Most recently, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 20-533 on December 15, 2020 recognizing the Nevada City Rancheria Tribe's historical, cultural and continued significance to Nevada County and supporting the restoration of Federal recognition of the Nevada City Rancheria Tribe. Additionally, the County's Value Statement on equity and inclusion highlights the importance to embrace collective responsibility and take actions that uphold racial and social equity.

Therefore, I recommend the Board adopt the attached Resolution proclaiming September 23, 2022 as Native American Day in Nevada County to acknowledge and support the historical and continued cultural significance of Native Americans in Nevada County.
