SUBJECT: Resolution approving Amendment No. 1 to the Personal Services Contract with Project H.E.A.R.T. Inc. to provide additional cognitive behavioral therapy-based services for adult and juvenile probation clients during fiscal year 2022-2023.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the Resolution.

<u>FUNDING</u>: This amendment increases the contract amount from \$50,000 to \$100,000, for fiscal year 2022-2023. This increase is 100% funded by a combination of Federal SAMHSA grant funds, State Community Corrections Performance funds (SB678) and Youthful Offender Block Grant (YOBG) funds. Funding is included in the FY 2022/2023 budget and no budget amendment is needed. No general fund monies are required.

BACKGROUND: Through this contract, Project H.E.A.R.T. supports probation involved individuals while they work to rebuild relationships, overcome life-damaging issues and establish skills to improve social stability. By providing access to peer support and pro-social community alternatives to criminal activity, Project H.E.A.R.T. supports Probation's mission to promote successful community and family integration through pro-social modes of treatment and engagement. Project HEART provides group and individual cognitive based treatment services and will begin engagement with clients while still in-custody, when applicable, to allow for a more successful reentry into the community. This amendment will expand capacity to serve probation clients at Wayne Brown Correctional Facility. Additionally, this amendment allows us to expand services provided to Nevada County youth housed within the Placer County Juvenile Detention Facility.
