OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

ACCEPTANCE OF THE NEVADA COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICER'S REQUEST TO TERMINATE THE LOCAL HEALTH EMERGENCY FOR THE AUGUST 2020 JONES FIRE. (RES. 20-403)

WHEREAS, California Health and Safety Code sections 101075, et seq, authorize the proclamation of a local health emergency by the Public Health Officer for any area of the County affected by hazardous waste which poses an immediate threat to public health; and

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2020, the Nevada County Interim Public Health Officer issued a Proclamation declaring the existence of a local health emergency, finding that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the County of Nevada were caused by the Jones Fire; and

WHEREAS, said Proclamation was ratified by Resolution 20-403 of the Board of Supervisors on September 1, 2020, which is within seven days of the Proclamation declaring the existence of a local health emergency by Nevada County's Interim Public Health Officer; and

WHEREAS, the situation resulting from said conditions of extreme peril is now deemed to be within the control of the normal protective services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of, and within, Nevada County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada does hereby proclaim the termination of said local health emergency.
