SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing acceptance of a Boating Safety and Enforcement Equipment Grant with the California Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways for reimbursement of boating equipment costs in the amount of \$29,000 for fiscal year 22/23 and approve the related budget amendment (4/5ths affirmative vote required).

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution

FUNDING: This discretionary funding is for FY 22/23 and will impact the Sheriff's Operations Budget in the amount of \$29,000 for both revenues and expenses. There will be no impact to the General Fund. A budget amendment will be required to reflect the additional revenue and expense.

BACKGROUND: The attached Resolution and Agreement are required by the California Department of Boating and Waterways for participation in the state's Boating Safety and Enforcement Equipment Grant program. This program provides funds for necessary equipment and repairs. Currently one of the Sheriff's Office patrol boat is inoperable due to an engine failure. This grant provides a maximum of \$29,000 for the re-motoring of the affected boat to reimburse the costs related to replacement of the failed engine for FY 22-23.

The Sheriff's Office has participated in this enforcement program for over forty years. This grant will allow the Sheriff's Office to use all boats for appropriate levels of patrolling. This has been reduced due to the nonfunctioning nature of one of the patrol boats.
