RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CHILDREN'S MEDICAL SERVICES (CMS) PLAN AND THE INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES, CHILDREN'S MEDICAL SERVICES BRANCH TO RECEIVE NEVADA COUNTY'S ALLOTMENT OF THE CALIFORNIA CHILDREN'S SERVICES (CCS) PROGRAM FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022/2023

WHEREAS, the California Department of Health Care Services requires that counties submit an annual Children's Medical Services (CMS) plan and budget; and

WHEREAS, the California Children's Services (CCS) program provides preventive and treatment related health care services to low income children and young adults; and

WHEREAS, the annual CMS plan and budget includes Certification Statements signed by the local governing body chairperson to indicate approval of the plan and compliance with applicable sections of the State Health and Safety Code; and

WHEREAS, the services provided under the CMS Plan will help eligible low-income residents have access to needed health care and preventive care.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, approves the Children's Medical Services (CMS) Plan and the Interagency Agreement with the State Department of Health Care Services, Children's Medical Services Branch to receive Nevada County's allotment of the California Children's Services (CCS) for Fiscal Year 2022/23, and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors and the Public Health Director are authorized to sign the CCS Certification on behalf of the County of Nevada.
