OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AIRPORT MANAGER TO SUBMIT BOTH AN APPLICATION FOR A FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION (FAA) **AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT** PROGRAM (AIP) PROJECT GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$220,500 AND AN APPLICATION FOR A **CALIFORNIA OF DEPARTMENT TRANSPORTATION** (CALTRANS) DIVISION OF AERONAUTICS AIP MATCHING GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$11,025 TO HELP FUND THE AIRPORT LAYOUT **NEVADA COUNTY** AT THE AIRPORT; AUTHORIZING THE IGS AGENCY DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE THE **APPLICATIONS**

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Airport is responsible for updating the Airport Layout Plan to reflect potential new projects; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Airport is required to ensure obstructions such as trees do not interfere with the safe operations of the airport in compliance with federal and state regulations; and

WHEREAS, the FAA Airport Improvement Program (AIP) will fund 90% of the cost of the construction of the Airport Layout Plan; and

WHEREAS, the application for CALTRANS Division of Aeronautics AIP matching grant is contingent upon the award of a FAA grant and would fund 4.5% of the Airport Layout Plan; and

WHEREAS, if awarded, the acceptance of these grants will be brought to the Board of Supervisors for approval per County policy.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Authorizes filing an application for a Federal Aviation Administration and state AIP matching grant for the Airport Layout Plan.
- 2. Authorizes the IGS Agency Director to sign any documents required to apply for these subject funds on behalf of the County of Nevada.
