OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING PARTICIPATION BY NEVADA COUNTY IN THE CALIFORNIA COUNTY ASSESSORS' INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AUTHORITY, A STATE FUNDED JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY (JPA) DEVELOPING PROJECTS BENEFITING ALL 58 COUNTIES AND AUTHORIZE THE ASSESSOR, IN COORDINATION WITH THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND COUNTY COUNSEL, TO COUNTERSIGN THE AGREEMENT AND ANY OTHER NECESSARY DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Assessor, in addition to other Assessors within the state of California would like to participate in the process of jointly implementing information technology (I.T.) solutions to assist in the standardization of statewide assessment practice the existence of a JPA that has qualified for grant funding and provides for more efficient statewide collaboration on the technology and data management solutions; and

WHEREAS, the formation deadline of November 15, 2022 of the JPA has been met with over thirty counties having already committed to participate; and

WHEREAS, the State has provided \$30,000,000 in funding with \$10,000,000 per year for three years commencing in 2022-2023 with no matching funds from the counties required; and

WHEREAS, the funded projects must benefit all 58 counties and all taxpayers with two projects having been reviewed and approved by the state; and

WHEREAS, the Joint Powers Authority may be terminated with notice of termination from two-thirds of the Member Agencies. Any Member Agency may withdraw from the JPA effective at the beginning of a fiscal year with at least ninety (90) days' written notice.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approves participation in the Joint Exercise of Powers Authority of the California County Assessors' Information Technology Authority and authorizes the Nevada County Assessor, in coordination with the County Executive Officer and County Counsel, to countersign the Agreement and any other necessary documents.
