**SUBJECT:** Recognize Technical Sergeant Breona Calvert for as the Lt. Commander Lou Conter Military Ambassador.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached Proclamation.

**FUNDING:** No funding required.

**BACKGROUND:** The County of Nevada and City of Grass Valley have partnered since 2022 to host the Grass Valley Armed Forces Day event. The event recognizes all actively serving members of all branches of the military, to include National Guard and reserves. Additionally, the event has an awards program honoring those members who excel in leadership, community service and are the epitome of a military citizen. The top award is called the Lt. Commander Lou Conter Military Ambassador.

The Lt. Commander Lou Conter Military Ambassador this year is from the California Air National Guard stationed at Beale Air Force Base CA. Technical Sergeant Breona Calvert has a long history of community service, extraordinary leadership and excels at her Military Duties. Technical Sergeant Calvert was selected by a panel of three elected members, the Mayor of Grass Valley and two Nevada County Supervisors.
