**SUBJECT:** Resolution approving execution of Amendment No. 1 to a Contract with Bright Futures for Youth for the provision of Youth Workforce Development activities in Western and Eastern Nevada County to increase the maximum contract price from \$667,624 to \$727,624 (an increase of \$60,000), and revise Exhibit "B", Schedule of Charges and Payments to reflect the increase in the maximum contract price and a term extension to September 30, 2024. (RES. 22-422)

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached Resolution.

**FUNDING:** Funding for this agreement is from the California Volunteers for Youth Workforce Development Program per Resolution Number 22-315 approved by the Nevada County Board of Supervisors on June 28, 2022. The funding will go through September 30, 2024. There will be no General Funds required.

**BACKGROUND:** On August 9, 2022, per Resolution 22-422, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approved execution of the Professional Services Contract with Bright Futures for Youth for the purpose of increasing youth employment, develop youth interest in and experience towards a career, and to strengthen capacity to address key areas of climate, food insecurity, and local COVID-19 recovery. Nevada County's program will recruit, train, and place high need youth at jobs in a new or existing youth workforce development program. Bright Futures for Youth will employ 42 youth over the life of this contract and will provide training and direct supportive services to ensure best outcomes and success of the youth served. Bright Futures for Youth works in collaboration with Connecting Point to create and/or develop existing partnerships with prospective employers in both Western and Eastern County.

It is recommended that the Board approve this amendment to increase the contract maximum to \$727,624 and extend the contract to September 30, 2024. This contract is being increased along with the extension so that we can serve more youth and provide

more services to the community.
