

# RESOLUTION No. 15-100

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION AND INSTALLATION OF AN UNINTERRUPTED POWER SUPPLY FOR THE REGIONAL DISPATCH CENTER TO BE CLASSIFIED AS A CAPITAL ASSET WITH RELATED BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014/15

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Sheriff's Office wishes to purchase an Uninterrupted Power Supply (UPS) for the Regional Dispatch Center to replace the current UPS which is undersized and soon to have an expired warranty; and

WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$9,100.00 have already been budgeted for the purchase of the UPS in the Fiscal Year 2014/15 budget; and


WHEREAS, additional funding is needed to cover the entire project cost of \$16,270, which includes equipment and installation costs; and

WHEREAS, the additional funding shall come from savings in the Class II expenses and be used in Class IV expenses with no additional cost to the General Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors hereby:

- 1) Approves the purchase and installation of a capital asset, the UPS equipment, which is an APC Symmetra LX battery back-up; and
- 2) Directs the Auditor/Controller to amend the Sheriff's Office Fiscal Year 14/15 budget as follows:
