County & Fire Collaboration

- Community Development Agency (CDA)
- Code Compliance
- Office of Emergency Services (OES)
- Local Fire Districts
- CalFire
- Ordinance is another tool for Fire



Three Phase Process



- Promote self abatement during Phase One requiring no ongoing County resources
- Fire conducts all field inspections and provides technical expertise
- Code enters the process in the middle of Phase Two

Phase One - Inspections - Fire

- Fire has the lead role in the first phase
- Credible complaint received
- Initial Inspection
 - Warning Notice of Violation to Owner and 30 Days
- 2nd Inspection
 - Notice of Violation to Owner and 30 Days
- Fire may issue a fire citation by their agency
- Fire may conduct additional formal or informal inspections

✓ *Samples and templates provided to Fire by Code*

Stopping at Phase One

- Self abatement
 - Better for the property owner
 - Better for the County
 - Better for Fire
- Requires no County resources
- Fire determines whether a property should move into the next phase
- Fire's last resort for compliance should rarely occur
- Estimate twice a year or less assuming the Placer County model

Phase Two - Pre-Abatement - Fire

- Fire's last resort for compliance and should rarely occur
 - Estimate twice a year or less (Placer County model)
 - Inspection Reports and Notice to Abate prepared for Local Fire Official
 - Local Fire Official signs Notice to Abate
 - Inspection to determine if abatement should continue
 - Post on property and mail notices to property owner
- ✓ *Samples and templates provided to Fire by Code*

Phase Two cont'd - Fire & Code

- Allow 10 days for appeal or 30 days to voluntarily abate
 - Appeal received within 10 days
 - County Clerk of the Board and Code will assist Fire with appeal hearing
 - Conduct appeal hearing and receive hearing officer's decision
 - No appeal, no self abatement, and 30 days
 - Move to abatement
 - Pre-Abatement joint inspection with Fire and Code
- ✓ Self abatement can occur anytime during Phase Two

Phase Three - Abatement - Code

- Abatement will be handled by Code
- Contract with vendor to perform the abatement
- Fire provide necessary technical inspections confirming the abatement is complete
- Bill property owner for abatement
- Record liens for unpaid bills and abatements
