SUBJECT: Resolution Approving Renewal of a Contract for Leachate Transport

Services from the McCourtney Road Closed Landfill in the Amount of

\$209,700 for Fiscal Year 2016/17

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached Resolution.

**<u>FUNDING</u>**: Funding is included in the Solid Waste Western Budget for Fiscal Year 2016/17. No budget amendment is needed, and there is no impact on the General Fund.

**BACKGROUND:** On November 12, 2013, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 13-492, awarding the contract for leachate transport services from the McCourtney Road closed landfill to Robinson Enterprises Investment Co., Inc. Subsequently, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolutions 14-284 and 15-286, to provide for annual renewals of the contract through June 30, 2016.

Staff recommends renewing the contract for a one-year period from July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017 with a not-to-exceed contract amount of \$209,700. The contract will allow for the removal of up to three million gallons of leachate from the storage tanks per year. Annually, the tanks accumulate from between 500,000 to three million gallons of leachate through the pumping system located at the landfill cells.
