SUBJECT:	Award of Contract for the McCourtney Road Landfill Leachate Pump Improvements Project – District IV

**<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>**: Approve the attached Resolution.

**<u>FUNDING</u>**: Funding for the project is for Fiscal Year 2016/17 and is funded through the Solid Waste Western Budget. No budget amendment is needed and there is no impact on the General Fund.

## **BACKGROUND**:

On September 13, 2016, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 16-449 that approved the plans, specifications and cost estimate for the subject project and instructed the Purchasing Division to advertise for bids. The bids were opened on October 12, 2016, at 3:00 p.m. and are listed below:

Award is recommended for the contract work to the low bidder, Innovative Construction Solutions at the bid price of \$169,995.00. The total amount to be encumbered is \$186,995.00, which includes a 10 percent of base bid contingency. Funds are available for the project in the Solid Waste Western Budget Fund.

This contract provides for upgrades and repairs for the two leachate pump stations located at the McCourtney Road Transfer Station. Construction is scheduled to begin in November/December 2016, and to be completed within 45 working days, as allowed for in the contract.
