SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing the Nevada County Sheriff to submit an application

to the California Department of Boating and Waterways for reimbursement of boating safety enforcement costs for the period July 1,

2017 to June 30, 2018 in the amount of \$245,987.07

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution

<u>FUNDING</u>: Not applicable. This is an application for financial aid from the California Department of Boating and Waterways to reimburse costs associated with the Sheriff's Office Boating Safety and Enforcement Program for FY 17/18.

BACKGROUND: The Nevada County Sheriff's Office has participated in the Cal Boating Safety and Enforcement Program for over 40 years. The program allows the Sheriff's Office to assign specially trained officers to patrol the county's waterways. Funds received from this program along with a portion of the personal property taxes assessed on boats, are allocated to pay the costs of officers' salaries and benefits, boats, training, maintenance, and other program related costs. Without it, there would be very minimal enforcement of watercraft law or boating safety regulations on our county waterways.

Although we are requesting \$245,987.07, we are anticipating receiving reimbursement funds more in line with prior funding amount of approximately \$96,000.
